Notice of Environmental Contamination

Pursuant to 18 AAC 78.280(d), Northern Petroleum Testing & Services, Inc., as owner of the subject property, hereby provides public notice that the property located at 1208 Gambell Street, Anchorage, Alaska, 99501, known as the former Quality Transmission facility, has been subject to the release of hazardous substances. The soil at the subject property is primarily contaminated with polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) and diesel-range organic petroleum hydrocarbons (DRO) that exceed 18 AAC 75.341 Tables B1 and B2 cleanup levels. Groundwater exceeds 18 AAC 75.345 Table C for residual range organics.

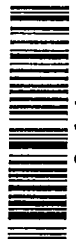
This site has been subject to a discharge or release and subsequent cleanup of oil and other hazardous substances, regulated under 18 AAC 75, Article 3, and 18 AAC 78, Article 6, as amended January 30, 2003. This release and site cleanup is documented in both the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation underground storage tank database and the Contaminated Sites database under file number 2100.38.368.

Subject to this institutional control, ADEC reviewed and approved the cleanup actions as being protective of human health, safety, welfare and the environment. There is groundwater and soil contamination remaining on site above established cleanup levels, but additional cleanup action is not required because the contamination does not pose a significant risk to human health, public safety, welfare, or the environment.

In the event that information becomes available which indicates that the site may pose an unacceptable risk to human health, safety, welfare or the environment, the land owner and/or operator is required under 18 AAC 75.300 to notify ADEC and evaluate the environmental status of the contamination in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. Further site characterization and cleanup may be necessary under 18 AAC 75.325-.390 and 18 AAC 78.600. Also, any transport, treatment, or disposal of any potentially contaminated soil or water from the site or use of the groundwater at or near the contaminated area requires notification to and approval from the Department in accordance with 18 AAC 78.600(h).

Attached is a diagram drawn to scale showing the property boundary of the former Quality Transmission facility, locations of monitoring wells MW1, MW2, and MW4, and the locations where contamination remains.

This notice remains in effect until a written determination from ADEC is recorded that states that the soil and groundwater at the site has been shown to meet the migration to groundwater soil cleanup levels in 18 AAC 75.341 Tables B1 and B2 and 18 AAC 75.345 Table C groundwater levels.

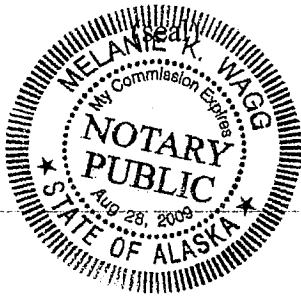

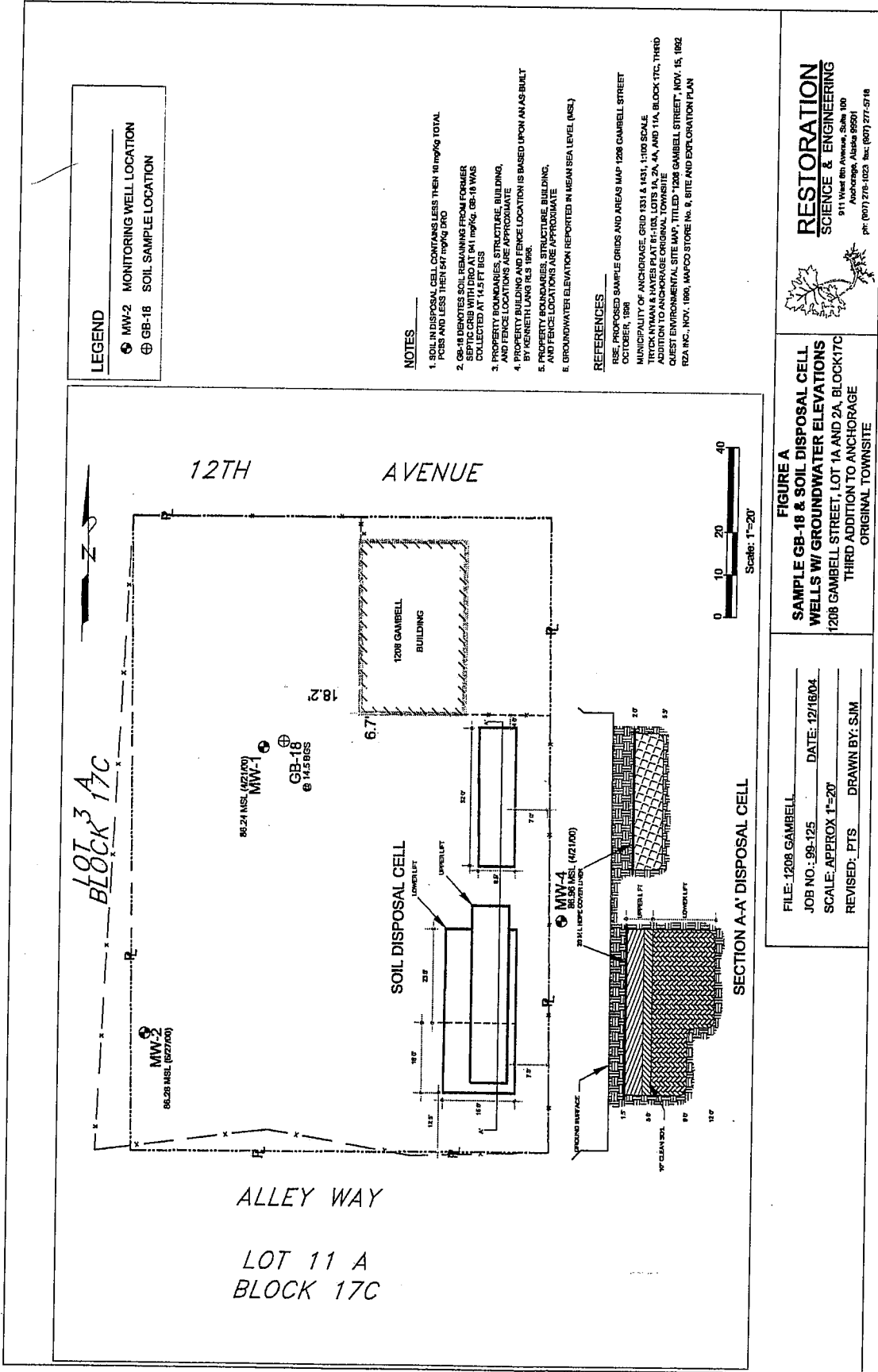
