
The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC), Contaminated Sites Program (CSP) recently issued a Record of Decision (ROD) for the waste oil tank source area at the Alyeska Pipeline Service Building in Fairbanks, AK after it had been determined that there was no unacceptable risk to human health or the environment. One of the conditions of this decision was that soil contamination remaining in this source be addressed when the soil becomes accessible.

Alyeska formally requested a no further remediation approval for this source area in a letter dated August 12, 2010. ADEC concurs using the following rationale:

- 1) The diesel range organic (DRO) concentrations remaining were found to be above Method Two Migration to Groundwater in 1993 at up to 532 mg/kg DRO. Groundwater monitoring data from downgradient wells showed various results but MW-11 which was downgradient did not contain benzene concentrations above Table C during the six monitoring events it was sampled. Finally, the use of groundwater at the property is restricted by the Institutional Controls.
- 2) The extent of contaminated soil remaining is at a depth of 11 feet below ground surface.
