
Dear Ms. Strause:

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) has reviewed the Final Site Investigation Report, Alaska Army National Guard Fairbanks OMS 5, November 2010.

This site investigation was performed to determine if soil contamination identified in 1996 remained. The report documents six soil borings and ten soil samples, along with the installation of one temporary groundwater monitoring well and one groundwater sample. Samples were analyzed for gasoline range organics, diesel range organics, residual range organics, benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene and xylene. All results were below the most stringent cleanup levels in 18 AAC 75.

The report meets the requirements of 18 AAC 75.380, Final Reporting Requirements. The DEC has determined that the cleanup is complete and the site is closed. This determination may be revised if new information becomes available indicating waste or contaminants at the site may pose an unacceptable risk to human health, safety, welfare or the environment.
