
Dear Mr. and Mrs. Winningham:

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) has recently completed review of the recent report titled: *Soil Treatment Cell Closure Sampling Results, Kenny Lake Mercantile*, submitted to our office by your consultant, Wood Canyon Group, Inc. The report was dated April 2, 2001 was received at our office on April 13, 2001, and addresses stockpile sampling results from a soil pile remaining on the referenced site resulting from the decommissioning of two underground storage tanks in 1997.

Based on our review of the information contained in this report, analytical results provided by your consultant, and two additional reports from 1997 pertaining to the closure of the UST system and overexcavation, the ADEC finds that the referenced site pertaining to the former locations of one 1,000-gallon gasoline petroleum underground storage tank (UST), and one 2,000-gallon gasoline tank, do not pose a significant threat to human health or the environment. The Department has therefore determined that no further remedial action or sampling is required at this location with respect to the closure of these tanks. The soil in the pile may be spread onsite in a non-environmentally sensitive area.

The ADEC reserves the right to request additional site assessment and remediation of contaminated areas should new information become available that suggests that contamination at this site may pose significant risks to human health or the environment.
