Re: Removal of Institutional Controls from Holiday Station Store #616/Williams Express Store #5016

Dear Mr. Anthony;

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) Contaminated Sites Program (CSP) has completed a review of the environmental records associated with Holiday Station Store #616/Williams Express Store #5016 located at 12021 Old Glenn Highway in Eagle River, Alaska. Remediation efforts following closure of the four underground storage tanks in 2012, have lowered contaminant concentrations to below ADEC's cleanup levels, found in Title 18 of the Alaska Administrative Code, Chapter 75, Section 341(b), Tables B1, B2, and Section 345(b) Table C to the point where remaining contamination no longer poses an unacceptable risk to human health or the environment. Therefore, no further remedial action will be required, and the institutional controls established in the August 19, 2009 Record of Decision will be removed.

This determination is in accordance with 18 AAC 78.276(f)(1) and does not preclude ADEC from requiring additional assessment and/or cleanup if future information indicates that this site may pose an unacceptable risk to human health or the environment.
