The final report referenced above incorporates acceptable responses to previously supplied comment. The report meets the requirements of 18 AAC 75.335 Site Characterization and is approved.


The release investigation shows that for all of the tanks investigated, except UST 37, the presence of diesel range organic (DRO) contamination is below the ground surface where impacts to human health and the environment are not expected and the DRO has not impacted the groundwater at the tank locations.

Releases from UST 37 have impacted the groundwater and remedial action is needed.

There are several wells in the old construction camp area that this investigation could not find and are presumed to have been destroyed. The Air Force has committed to locating and properly abandoning those destroyed wells and will install at least one monitoring well to further delineate the groundwater impacts from UST 37.
