Dear Sir or Madame:

This is to inform you that the Department is in the process of reviewing old files on releases to see if any further work is required or if they can be closed out. I have reviewed the file on this site and have found that on 13 September 91, the ADEC Regional Administrator issued a letter stating that neither ADEC nor EPA planned to conduct any further work at this site. Therefore, the Department now considers this site closed. The Contaminated Sites database will reflect this action.

This site is located across Cook Inlet from Kenai, on Tyonek Native Corporation property. The legal description is T11N, R11W, Section 8, 9, 16, or 17, S.M. An overflight during the summer of 1988 identified approximately 15 drums at this site. At the time it was assumed that the drums had been abandoned. A subsequent overflight in 1991 found no drums or signs of contamination. A Preliminary Assessment Report substantiated this finding.
