Dear Mr. Lundeby:

The Anchorage District Office has reviewed file information regarding soils excavated adjacent to the Merrill Field tower during water line construction in 1990. This office approved a plan to place, compact, and pave over the fixated soils. You have requested, through a letter of October 26, 1994 from your consultant, Sound Environmental, that the requirement for paving be waived based on the fact that the fixated soils are highly compacted and of low permeability, and are contoured so that no surface water can collect on any part of the surface of the area. The Department waives the requirement for paving and requires no further action with respect to the fixated soils with the following condition:

The area where the fixated soil have been placed must be visually monitored for a period of five years following the date of this letter. The area must be inspected for subsidence, cracking, or other conditions which could allow infiltration of surface water into or through the fixated soils. In the event that such conditions are noted by Airport or Department personnel, this office must be notified immediately and Department-approved corrective action taken. Required corrective action may entail paving the area.
