I am pleased to inform you that the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) has changed the site status of the Peard Bay DEW Line to “Closed” on the Contaminated Sites data base. This closure became effective on September 15, 2005, upon joint signing of a decision document by authorized representatives of DEC and the Corps of Engineers. The Decision document consists of a Declaration of Site Closure and the supporting *No DOD Action Indicated Report – Peard Bay DEW Line Station*. The report provides a detailed summary of the investigation and cleanup actions that were conducted at the site, and explains the basis for determining that cleanup is complete.
