Dear Mr. Mulkey:

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation, Contaminated Sites Program, (ADEC) amended the conditional closure decision for the East Fork Maintenance facility. The condition to sample the groundwater in 2006 is no longer required. The shallow groundwater (i.e. 5 feet bgs) and the low levels of DRO indicate that the contamination may be a result of the soil - groundwater interface (smear zone) that will attenuate over time. The site is no longer active and there are no receptors as indicated in the May 2006 decision document.

Based on this information, ADEC has determined further groundwater monitoring at this site is not required and the current environmental status will be reflected in the ADEC database. All other terms and conditions of the decision remain the same.


Any person who disagrees with this decision may request an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 18 AAC 15.195 - 18 AAC 15.340 or an informal review by the Division Director in accordance with 18 AAC 15.185. Informal review requests must be delivered to the Division Director, P.O. Box 111800, 410 Willoughby Avenue, Suite 303, Juneau, Alaska 99811-1800, within 15 days of the decision. Adjudicatory hearing requests must be delivered to the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Conservation, P.O. Box 111800, 410 Willoughby Avenue, Suite 303, Juneau, Alaska 99811-1800, within 30 days of the decision. If a hearing is not requested within 30 days, the right to appeal is waived.
