Dear Mr. Schnabel:

The department has received and reviewed the analytical sample results from the contaminated soil stockpile at 4.5 Mile Haines Highway which were submitted this morning via facsimile. Eight (8) samples were collected on May 29, 2002 by Bill Joiner of Bristol Environmental & Engineering Services Corporation. The samples were analyzed for gasoline range organics and diesel range organics by Alaska Methods AK 101 and 102, respectively. All contaminants of concern were found to be below the department's most stringent cleanup levels of 18 Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) 75.341, Table B2 for the over 40" rainfall climate zone of 260 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg) gasoline range organics and 230 mg/kg diesel range organics.

This soil is considered to be clean by the department and no additional sampling or cleanup actions will be required. The soil can be used in any location that is not wetlands or any other ecologically sensitive environment. This site is now considered to be closed and will be indicated as such on the Underground Storage Tank database.
