Dear Mr. Pollock:

On March 28, 2019, the Kenai Area Office of the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC), received Integrity Environmental's March 28, 2019, Frosty Fuels Soil Stockpile Closure letter-report documenting the final disposal of previously contaminated soils excavated from the Cold Bay Frosty Fuel Return Pipeline Spill "site". Thank you for authorizing the oversight duties and the preparation of this report, for ADEC regulatory review and processing.

Some of the soils had been stored on Lot 4, Block 3 of Plat 79-6 (Lot 4) since 1992. On July 6, 2018, ADEC issued a determination that these soils had been demonstrated to meet ADEC's most restrictive 18 AAC 75 method 2 soil cleanup levels, and that no further remedial work was required on these soils.

On October 30, 2018, ADEC issued concurrence of Integrity Environmental's proposal to dispose of the soils on Lot 4, which could improve the access drive to, and the parking lot on, Lot 4. Our October 30<sup>th</sup> concurrence required that ADEC receive a post-soil disposal report, prepared by a qualified environmental professional, which identified the final location of soil disposal. Integrity Environmental's March 28<sup>th</sup> letter report satisfies that reporting requirement. Again, thank you for completing these work tasks.

We consider the disposal of these soils to be complete. No further response action is required in association with these soils, and no further assessment or cleanup work is required on Lot 4 due to the disposal of these soils on Lot 4.
