Dear Mr. Anthony:

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation, Contaminated Sites Program (ADEC) issued a Corrective Action Complete with Institutional Controls decision on December 4, 2009 for the Holiday Station Store #630 sites located at 3727 Spenard Road in Anchorage. As you are aware, another release occurred at this facility on January 4, 2010. Information obtained to date suggests that soil contamination exists in the area that warrants further cleanup and/or monitoring efforts. Finally, a signed agreement to the conditions of the decision has not yet been received by ADEC. Therefore, ADEC has decided that the status of this facility is to remain an active contaminated site and rescinds the December 2009 decision.
