
Dear Mr. Saltz:

The Department of Environmental Conservation (Department) is requesting additional information regarding the July 19, 1997, closure of two regulated underground storage tanks (UST) that took place on your property at 18.3 mile Kalifornsky Beach Road. Our records indicate each of the two USTs had a capacity of 2,000 gallons and stored kerosene. A review of the post-closure notice indicated Mr. Harold Jackson, a non-qualified person, did a visual site assessment of the UST excavation. I spoke to Mr. Jackson regarding his role in the site assessment. It is Mr. Jackson contention that the tanks were not regulated because they stored fuel used for heating purposes therefore, a site assessment by a qualified person, including laboratory samples was not required. In August, I made several unsuccessful attempts to speak to you to get more information about the tanks and to clarify the use of the product stored.

Because there is a discrepancy between the information we originally received from you and your current knowledge of the tanks, the Department is requesting you to provide additional information to support your belief that the USTs should not be considered regulated. Please provide the Department with the necessary documentation within 30 days. The information should be sent to Timothy Stevens at ADEC/STP, 555 Cordova Street, Anchorage, AK 99501.
