At your service. Copies of the Closure Notices in our file have been sent US mail to Dave Guinn.

Looks like 4 tanks were closed altogether. Two regulated, and perhaps two unregulated.

The consultant never analyzed soil samples for DRO even though one of the regulated tanks contained diesel fuel. We are unable to close the site out without the DRO analytical data on the closure assessment soil samples showing that the site isn't impacted by diesel fuel. The qualified third party states in their September 25, 1998 report that **"Because NTL was not informed there was a diesel tank prior to DEC submittal of sample work plan, samples were not sampled or analyzed for diesel range organics."**
