Dear Ms. Browning:

We periodically review the status of open contaminated sites in our records, in an effort to bring these sites to closure. The Kasilof Riverview Lodge site remains open in our records and in ADEC's Contaminated Sites Program database. We recently reviewed our records for your site and learned that on June 13, 2005, ADEC issued approval of the Monitoring Well Sampling, Groundwater Flow, and Stockpile Remediation Plan dated June 3, 2005, which was prepared by your consultant, Alaska Consulting and Environmental Engineering (ACE). This plan included another groundwater sampling event to occur in August 2005, and remediation, sampling and disposal of the contaminated soils that are stockpiled on your property. A copy of the ACE's June 3rd plan, and ADEC's June 13th approval letter are attached, for your information and use.

We find no further correspondence or reports in our records from either you or your consultant after June 13, 2005. If the approved work has been completed, please provide our office with a copy of any report(s) documenting the work accomplished.

The two remaining requirements that must be accomplished before ADEC could consider issuance of a closure decision for your site are groundwater sampling and analysis in order to identify petroleum concentrations in groundwater, and the proper treatment/disposal of the approximately 200 cubic yards of contaminated soils that are stockpiled on site. After groundwater quality monitoring is considered complete, the groundwater monitoring wells will also need to be properly decommissioned.
