Dear Mr. Browning:

On August 3, 2017, the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation, Contaminated Sites Program (ADEC), issued a letter to you in summarizing our findings in response to our review of the Alaska Consulting and Environmental Engineering January 5, 2017, **Final Stockpile Soil Spread Former Stockpile Location Soil Sampling, Monitoring Well Sampling** report for the Kasilof Riverview Lodge “site”. A copy of that August 3, 2017 letter is attached, for your information.

Our August letter required the submittal a corrective action plan by August 31st of last year, in accordance with 18 AAC 78.250 (Corrective action plan). Alaska regulation requires that the corrective action plan be prepared and signed by a qualified environmental professional. Mr. Arne Tikka was the qualified environmental professional that performed the field work and prepared the January 5, 2017 report that was provided to our office, and sadly, we learned that Mr. Tikka passed away last fall. This means you will need to employ another qualified environmental professional to prepare the required corrective action plan.

It’s been more than six months since we issued our August, 2017 letter to you. We now require that the corrective action plan be prepared and provided to our office *by no later than April 30, 2018*. The work tasks to be included in the plan are identified in our August 3, 2017 letter, which is attached.

Additionally, we require that you provide a written response to this letter by no later than March 16, 2018, informing us of your intentions for providing us with the corrective action plan, and providing

a schedule of proposed action(s) which will ensure the corrective action plan will be prepared and submitted to our office by April 30, 2018.
