2019 Monitoring and Site Investigation Work Plan

ADEC Work Plan Approval

Dear Mr. Boyer;

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation Contaminated Sites Program (ADEC), has reviewed the April 19, 2019 Monitoring and Site Investigation Work Plan. Thank you for providing this work plan which was received in our office on April 23, 2019. The work plan is approved with the following conditions.

Section 5.2.1 states that the direct push borehole will collapse and be abandoned. This approach will not be acceptable. Boreholes on the beach must be pressure grouted from the base of the borehole up at abandonment.

Offshore plume identification boreholes/sample locations will include testing for SVOC and PAH compounds.

Pore water samples (Section 3.4), located at the direct push groundwater sampling locations, and collected from 0.5 to 1 foot below ground surface on the tidal flats, will be analyzed for TAH and TAqH.

We understand that Monitoring well M-102D has been damaged. This well appears to be an important data point. If the well is unusable, please replace the well.
