Dear Ms. Segev:

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) has received and reviewed the *Kenai Lake Trailer Park Trailer #4 Site Characterization and Groundwater Monitoring Report*, prepared by Environmental Management, Inc. and dated September 9, 2020. This report includes the requested revisions to the draft version and is approved in accordance with 18 Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) 75.335(d).

This report documents soil characterization and groundwater monitoring conducted in June 2020. Five (5) soil borings were advanced and elevated concentrations of petroleum hydrocarbon contamination were detected in all directions from the former heating oil tank location. Also, the five (5) previously-installed groundwater wells were sampled. Petroleum hydrocarbon constituents were detected in two (2) wells with only exceedances found in the one (1) well located closest to the former tank location. Recommend future actions are included in Section 9.0 of the report and include additional soil characterization to delineate the extent of contamination and resampling the two (2) groundwater wells which had detected petroleum hydrocarbons constituents. DEC concurs with these recommendations.
