## Dear Sirs:

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) is sending you this letter regarding the Kenai Airport Fuel Service site referenced above because our records depict that you are the responsible parties for the historical fuel releases that occurred at this site. The first intent of this letter is to inform you that I have been assigned project manager responsibilities for the Kenai Airport Fuel Service site. Please direct future correspondence regarding this site to me.

I have reviewed the site file in an attempt to determine the current status of the site. From information available in our file, the in-situ treatment system was last operated in 2007, as documented in the June 2008 Remedial Action Report #5 Kenai Airport Fuel Service.

We find no further correspondence or reports in our records from either you or your consultant after June 2008. If additional work has been completed, please provide our office with a copy of any report(s) documenting the work accomplished.

If no additional work has been completed, and no additional reports are available, then provide information on the current status of the site and present a corrective action work plan for additional work to complete this cleanup project. The corrective action work plan must include the following work tasks:

- 1. Establish current groundwater quality in site monitoring wells;
- 2. Re-confirm groundwater flow direction;

- 3. Identify surface water conditions in the drainage ditch, (evaporation pond);
- 4. Present a discussion regarding the condition of the air-sparge vapor extraction remediation system; and
- 5. Include recommendations for additional remediation system operation.
