Re: Product Recovery at Flowline Alaska

Dear Ms. Hays:

Thank you for providing the requested information documenting product recovery at the Flowline site. Based on the information provided in the Response to Meeting Comments letter dated December 31, 2015, the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) concurs with the conclusion that product recovery is no longer effective at this site.

Monitoring well MW-1 was used as a product recovery well from 2009 to 2013. A peristaltic pump was used to purge the floating product into 55-gallon drums staged on-site. A total of approximately 325 pounds of product was recovered. In 2012, three 55-gallon drums of the recovered product were disposed of at Organic Incineration Technology, Inc. (OIT). No product was observed in MW-1 in 2014 or 2015.
