Dear Ms. Lathrop;

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) Contaminated Sites Program has reviewed the Trading Bay Production Facility 2022 Groundwater Monitoring and Site Investigation Work Plan dated May 20, 2022. Thank you for providing this work plan which was received in our office on June 3, 2022. The work plan is not approved with the following comments.

ADEC is requiring an additional work plan, or addendum to this work plan, to address the following two items:

1. ADEC is requiring that Chevron collect a water sample from the outfall of the remediation system pumping wells and test that sample for PFAS compounds, including PFOS and PFOA. The discovery of these compounds in groundwater on the site makes it necessary to do so as water from the remediation system discharges to Cook Inlet.
2. Please capture LNAPL recovery data and track recovery historical recovery over time. This theoretically will allow us to track remediation and natural attenuation information and provide insight to potential releases within the facility.
