Stantec is submitting this letter report on behalf of Chevron Environmental Management Company (CEMC) to provide second quarter 2022 monitoring results for the Pipe and Supply (P&S) Yard groundwater treatment system (GTS) at Swanson River Field, Sterling, Alaska (P&S Yard site). There is no change in the status of the GTS, which remains shut down.

Groundwater had been collected and treated via air stripping then discharged to a leach field located south of the site from 1992 until the GTS was shut down on 01 November 2016. Monitoring of the GTS is currently being conducted in accordance with AECOM's 2017 Treated Groundwater Disposal Plan, dated April 2017. The GTS remains shut down and no water has been treated or discharged to the leach field since November 2016. CEMC and Stantec currently have no plans to restart the GTS.
