Thank you for providing this report which was received in our office on May 23, 2023. The report is approved with the following comments.

In future reports, please include a figure that defines the different source area that are referenced, (A, B & C etc.)

In the next annual report, please present a discussion on the expected lifespan of the permeable reactive barrier and when is it expected to become saturated at current loading rates? What are the options for replacing or amending the barrier? Please present a contingency plan that addresses a failure of the permeable reactive barrier.

As the beach bluff is a dynamic environment, subject to erosion, DEC would like a contingency plan for the southern plume remediation/abatement, should the air sparge system fail.
