Ms. Lehl:

On November 16, 2023, the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation, (DEC) Contaminated Sites Program, received the *PFAS Investigation Work Plan*. The work plan was prepared by Trihydro. DEC has the following comments.

The work plan states, "Purge water removed from the wells will be discharged to the Refinery wastewater treatment system consistent with current groundwater sampling purge water management practices at the Refinery." If investigation derived waste, purge water and soil spoils, are found to contain PFAS compounds above DEC action levels after analytical testing, these materials will be disposed of at a permitted facility. Sample results will be reported to DEC prior to disposal of spoils, as results will dictate where materials can be disposed.
