Beluga River Unit 224-13 ADEC Work Plan Comments

Mr. Farris,

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation, Contaminated Sites Program (ADEC) has reviewed the *Groundwater Monitoring 2024 Work Plan BRU – M Pad –* Beluga River Unit Site 224-13, associated with five open sites in the Beluga River Field, located on the west side of Cook Inlet, near Tyonek, Alaska. The report was received in our office on August 9, 2024. This letter concerns Beluga River Unit 224-13 site. ADEC has the following comments.

Site 224-13: A new downgradient well should be installed down gradient of the 224-13 well head. Well 224-13-3 is not directly downgradient of the Beluga River 224-13 well, a likely source of groundwater impacts. A new well location further north of 224-13-3 will give a better assessment of pad water quality.
