On April 16, 2026, the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation, Contaminated Sites Program (ADEC), received the 2025 Groundwater Monitoring Report, dated April 16, 2026. This document was prepared by Trihydro Corporation. The report is approved.

DEC reiterates our request to test for Lead and the compounds ethylene dibromoethane and 1,2-dichloroethane in the assessment of surface water and sediments in the area of the pipeline breach. We understand that our previous request arrived after last years field sampling event.

We request that Marathon install a surface water measuring gauge in the wetlands on the eastern site and include that water elevation on what is Figure 5, the Perched Aquifer Potentiometric Surface Map. This measuring gauge is requested to understand the influence the wetlands might have on the perched aquifer.
