

**SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ON PROPOSED
CHANGES TO
ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION REGULATIONS**

The Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC), proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 18, Chapter 50 of the Alaska Administrative Code. The changes would accomplish the following: 1) update the State Air Quality Control Plan to adopt by reference "Juneau's Mendenhall Valley PM₁₀ Limited Maintenance Plan," and 2) update the reference at 18 AAC 50.030(2) to the Code of the City and Borough of Juneau for declaring "Air pollution alerts and emergencies" so that it references the current Code as amended by the City and Borough in September 2008. This supplemental notice corrects the web address in paragraph four.

You may comment on the proposed regulation changes, including the potential costs to private persons of complying and alternative practical methods of complying with the proposed changes, by submitting written comments to Scott Sloane, Environmental Program Specialist, Air Quality Division, Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation, 410 Willoughby Avenue Suite 303, Juneau, Alaska 99801, or by facsimile at: (907) 465-5129. Comments must be received by 5:00 p.m., on February 6, 2009. Comments received after this date will not be considered in final action on these rules.

The Department will hold a public hearing on this proposal on February 3, 2009, from 12:30-1:30 pm, at the DEC second floor main conference room, 410 Willoughby Avenue, Juneau. Oral or written comment may be submitted at the hearing. The hearing will be extended if necessary to accommodate those present before 1:30 pm who did not have an opportunity to comment. If you will not be able to attend the public hearing in person, please contact Scott Sloane at (907) 465-5176 by January 23, 2009, to make arrangements to participate by phone. The State of Alaska, Department of Environmental Conservation complies with Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990. 
