This Document is to remind you of your Preapproved Emission Limit reporting obligations and to assist you in complying with those requirements. Please be reminded that it is not necessary that you submit copies of fuel receipts along with the annual calculations. You are required only to retain the fuel receipts for five years, and make them available for department inspection upon request. In accordance with applicable regulations 18 AAC 50.230(a)(b)(c)(1)(A)-(H) and (c)(2)(A)-(D), or 18 AAC 50.230(a)(d)(1)(A)-(D), (d)(2)(A)-(D), and your preapproved emission limit, you have agreed to:

Diesel Engines facilities

- Limit the quantity of fuel consumed in the equipment listed in your application during any consecutive 12 months to no more than the amount proposed in your application;
- Record the amount of fuel consumed in the equipment and calculate the total fuel consumed in the equipment during the preceding 12 months.

Gasoline Distribution facilities

- Limit the quantity of gasoline transferred from tanks at the facility each day to less than 19,900 gallons;
- Record the amount of gasoline transferred from tanks at the facility each day.

By applying for and accepting the preapproved emission limit, as opposed to a permit, you are obligated to report to the Department once a year the compliance status of your facility.
