Subject: Pacific Energy Resources, Ltd. (PERL) for the Osprey Platform - Air Quality Control  
Minor Permit No. AQ0696MSS02, Revision 1 (Transfer of Ownership)

Dear Mr. Elder and Mr. Paspalof:

Under the authority of AS 46.14.285, the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (the Department) is administratively revising the air quality control minor permit for PERL's Osprey Platform. The permit contains the applicable provisions of AS 46.14 and 18 AAC 50. The terms and conditions of this minor permit remain effective until modified or revoked by the Department, regardless of any change in ownership of the stationary source or its emission units. The responsibilities imposed by this minor permit may not be transferred without the written consent of the Department.

The Department received a letter requesting the transfer of ownership from Forest Oil to PERL on January 25, 2008. The Department finds that this is a revision to be a non-substantive element of the minor permit under 18 AAC 50.546(b). This administrative revision to the permit does not change the technical basis for the permit provision, provided in the Technical Analysis Report for Permit No. AQ0696MSS02 dated October 23, 2007.

This administrative revision does not relieve the new permittee from the responsibility to apply for any other permit or approval required by the Department, the U.S. Environmental Agency (EPA), or local governments. Please be advised that the State regulations may differ from federal regulations. If you have any questions regarding compliance with federal regulations, you should contact EPA.

Any person who disagrees with this decision may request an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 18 AAC 15.195 - 18 AAC 15.340 or an informal review by the Division Director in accordance with 18 AAC 15.185. Informal review requests must be delivered to the Division Director, 619 Ship Creek Avenue, Suite 249, Anchorage, AK 99501, within 15 days of the permit decision. Adjudicatory hearing requests must be delivered to the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Conservation, 410 Willoughby Avenue, Suite 303, PO Box 111800, Juneau, AK 99811-1800, within 30 days of the permit decision. If a hearing is not requested within 30 days, the right to appeal is waived.
