




# 30 TIPS IN 30 DAYS

## 2015 National Preparedness Month

### // Week 4: September 20-26<sup>th</sup>

- Brace overhead lighting fixtures.
- Ensure equipment is fastened or stabilized.
- Place breakable objects in a closed cabinet with a latch.
- Anchor storage tanks.
- Reinforce or improve utility transmission lines and connections.
- Consider alternate transportation/evacuation routes for staff if roads are obstructed or damaged.
- Consider future mitigation measures that can potentially decrease damage and increase utility resilience (i.e., replace seismically weak pipes and wellheads).
