- Do not leave any blanks.
- You **must** take the Core Exam. (Exception – you have passed the Core Exam in the past 12 months, and you simply want to add more Categories.)
- You must select **at least one** Category Exam. See website for [category descriptions](#). If you need assistance determining the correct Category, please call us at 907-376-1870.
- Online proctored exams are available during normal testing center business hours. Testing centers charge a fee to administer exams; this is a **separate fee** from the license/certification fee that you will pay to DEC once you pass the exams. You will pay this fee directly to the testing center when you go in to take the exam. Fees vary, but are generally between \$30 and \$50 per test.
- Paper and pencil exams. If you are unable to take an exam at an on-line testing center, we will try to arrange a proctor to administer the exams to you in a paper and pencil format. There may be a delay in locating and arranging a proctor for these exams. We will contact you with information about where and when to take your exams. Proctors charge a fee to administer exams.
- Once the Pesticide Control Program receives this registration form, **we will e-mail you** with an exam approval and details about how to contact the testing center in your area to schedule a time to take your exams. You must take the exam within 100 days of your approval date.

DEC will email you an invoice for the \$25 DEC fee and a reminder to submit proof of liability insurance (Unless you designate as a Private Applicator).

If you pass the exams but do not submit the \$25 DEC fee and proof of liability insurance we will hold your card until you submit the required items.

YOU ARE NOT CERTIFIED UNTIL DEC HAS ISSUED YOU A CERTIFIED PESTICIDE APPLICATOR NUMBER, AND YOU HAVE RECEIVED YOUR CERTIFIED PESTICIDE APPLICATOR CARD.
