**Original Soupman Lobster Bisque Recalled
for Undeclared Allergens**

(JUNEAU, AK) – The Original Soupman Company has issued a recall for specific lots of its Lobster Bisque because some cartons do not declare the presence of shrimp, perch, or tilapia and known allergens, in the ingredients statement. People who have an allergy or have a severe sensitivity to crustacean shellfish or other seafood run the risk of a serious or life-threatening allergic reaction if they consume this product.

The affected product can be identified by the lot numbers stamped on the top of the 17 oz. Tetra Pak carton.
