Safeway Select French Salted Caramel Premium Ice Cream recalled due to undeclared peanut allergen

(JUNEAU, AK) – Safeway has issued a recall for select containers of Safeway Select French Salted Caramel (Fleur De Sel) Premium Ice Cream sold from Nov. 4, 2014 through Dec. 5, 2014 because the product may contain undeclared peanuts, a known allergen. People who have an allergy or have a severe sensitivity to peanuts run the risk of a serious or life-threatening allergic reaction if they consume this product.

The affected products can be identified by the UPC Code located on the side panel and the Best Before Date located on the bottom of the package.
