**Popsicles Recalled for Potential Milk Allergen**

(JUNEAU, AK) – Unilever United States has issued a recall for 20-count boxes of orange, cherry and grape flavored Popsicles that may have been exposed to milk not declared on the label. People who have an allergy or have a severe sensitivity to milk run the risk of serious or life-threatening allergic reaction if they consume this product.

The recalled product is packaged in paper boxes that have the UPC codes printed on the side of each box.
