compliance with Phase II NPDES requirements. It will also assist in coordinating concerns regarding the Chena River, a Category I watershed, with the Lower Chena River Watershed Management Strategy Committee, and the Noyes Slough Action Committee.

The work represents the third year of a planned multi-year effort. The multi-year project schedule is necessary because of the limited mapping field season, the limited staff, concurrent model development, and the extent of the mapping effort.

Evaluation of Environmental Benefits:

The City will maintain an evaluation process throughout each project task to insure the project objective is being accomplished as intended. Progress will be monitored for extent of work completed and amount of budget expended. Reporting requirements will provide a check on progress and finances. Submittals will be reviewed for timeliness and content. If quality of work product, scope, budget, or target dates are not being achieved, in-house adjustments or amendments to the work plan will be initiated.
