

NOASH Rationale Affidavit

An owner or operator of a solid fuel-fired heating device may continue to use their device during a curtailment only if a written temporary waiver is received. In order to receive a temporary No Other Adequate Source (NOASH) waiver, one of the following must apply and be demonstrated:

Eligibility

- 1) The subject structure must be heated and the structure has no adequate heating source without using a SFBA;
- 2) Economic hardship requires use of the SFBA;
- 3) Complying with the restriction would result in damage to property including damage to the appliance itself and its heating components;
- 4) No documented curtailment violations
