This letter serves to notify the Seward Association for the Advancement of Marine Science (SAAMS) that the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation issued the above referenced permit for the ASLC on April 13, 2020 to reflect a five-year permit period. The permit will be effective June 1, 2020 and will expire at midnight, May 31, 2025. You should begin operations under the new permit on June 1, 2020.

State regulations at 18 AAC 83.020(a) require that an APDES permit be effective for a fixed term not to exceed five years. The requirement to reapply for permit reissuance is on or before November 30, 2024, 180 days before the expiration of the above referenced permit.
