As part of our commitment to continue serving the regulated community during these unprecedented times, the Division of Air Quality is improving the robustness of its electronic document system, that includes handling of e-mail delivered to the Division of Air Quality via [DEC.AQ.Airreports@alaska.gov](mailto:DEC.AQ.Airreports@alaska.gov). This effort requires changes to the configuration of this mailbox, which will take 2-3 days to complete. The mailbox should be again accessible starting on Monday, April 20<sup>th</sup>.
