Notice of Application for State Water Quality Certification

Any applicant for a federal license or permit to conduct an activity that might result in a discharge into navigable waters, in accordance with Section 401 of the Clean Water Act (CWA) of 1977 (PL95-217), also must apply for and obtain certification from the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation that the discharge will comply with the CWA, the Alaska Water Quality Standards, and other applicable State laws.

Notice is hereby given that a request for a CWA §401 Water Quality Certification of a Department of the Army Permit application, Corps of Engineers' Reference Number POA-2012-00919, Sagavanirktok River, has been received for the discharge of dredged and/or fill materials into waters of the United States (WOUS), including wetlands, as described below and shown on the enclosed project figures/drawings. Project Name: Norgasco Pad Expansion

Location: The proposed activity is located within Section 8, T. 10 N., R. 15 E., Umiat Meridian; Latitude 70.235869° N., Longitude -148.385758° W.; in Prudhoe Bay, Alaska.

Purpose: The applicant's stated purpose is to develop the north slope site in order to grow as needed to provide adequate support of the service areas as the surrounding fields develop.

Project Description: The proposed project would expand the existing gravel pad. The applicant proposes placement of approximately 20,000 cubic yards (CY) of material into 3.2 acres of WOUS, including wetlands, to expand the pad. Geotextile fabric would be used prior to gravel placement to minimize cross-media environmental impacts.

After reviewing the application, the Department may certify there is reasonable assurance the activity, and any discharge that might result, will comply with the CWA, the Alaska Water Quality Standards, and other applicable State laws. The Department also may deny or waive certification.
