Proposed Project and Location:

The University of Alaska – Southeast (UAS) operates the Anderson Building Facility. The Anderson Building Facility houses laboratory tanks for studying sea organisms used for academic research at the University near Juneau, Alaska. Seawater is pumped into the Anderson Building Facility from Auke Bay, flows through the tanks holding local aquatic life and is discharged without treatment to Auke Bay at one outfall located at 58.38000° North latitude and 134.64420° West longitude. No mixing zone is authorized.
