Any applicant for a federal license or permit to conduct an activity that might result in a discharge into navigable waters, in accordance with Section 401 of the Clean Water Act (CWA) of 1977 (PL95-217), also must apply for and obtain certification from the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation that the discharge will comply with the CWA, the Alaska Water Quality Standards, and other applicable State laws.

Notice is hereby given that a request for a CWA §401 Water Quality Certification of a Department of the Army Permit application, Corps of Engineers' Reference Number POA-2020-00332, Neilson Creek, has been received for the discharge of dredged and/or fill materials into waters of the United States (WOUS), including wetlands, as described below and shown on the enclosed project figures/drawings. Location: The proposed activity is located within Section 8, T. 41 S., R. 67 E.; Latitude 58.323582 N., Longitude -134.498288° W.; located on Douglas Island in Juneau, Alaska.

Purpose: The purpose of this project is to develop 12 residential lots for the express purpose of providing housing.

Project Description: The applicant proposes placement of approximately 24,926 cubic yards (CY) of material into 70 acres of wetlands. The proposed project would take the existing 91-acre parcel and subdivide it into 12 (D3) residential lots of varying size.)

After reviewing the application, the Department may certify there is reasonable assurance the activity, and any discharge that might result, will comply with the CWA, the Alaska Water Quality Standards, and other applicable State laws. The Department also may deny or waive certification.
