NOTICE OF REVIEW OF AN ALASKA POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (APDES) PRELIMINARY DRAFT PERMIT

TO DISCHARGE TO WATERS OF THE UNITED STATES

Proposed Project and Location:

Wastewater is treated to secondary standards at the Homer WWTF. Treatment at the facility consists of primary treatment, deep-shaft activated sludge, flotation clarifiers, an ultraviolet radiation disinfection chamber and a supplemental/back-up chlorination and dechlorination unit. The treated wastewater is then discharged to Kachemak Bay through the facility's outfall at approximately 2178 feet (664 meters) offshore located at 59° 37' 58" North latitude and 151° 32' 52" West longitude. The Facility has a continuous discharge which occurs at a monthly average rate of 880,000 gallons per day to Kachemak Bay. A mixing zone is proposed for ammonia, fecal coliform, and enterococci bacteria.
