The Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) proposes to change regulations in Title 18, Chapter 32 of the Alaska Administrative Code, Milk and Milk Products. The amendment proposes allowing the sale of raw milk and raw milk products, and conforming and clarifying edits.

The full contents of all submitted comments are considered public records and will be posted online in full during the public comment period. If you are unable to submit comment via this site, you may submit them by mail to Shannon Miller, Department of Environmental Conservation, 555 Cordova Street, Anchorage, AK 99501. Additionally, the Department of Environmental Conservation will accept comments by facsimile at (907) 269-7654, by electronic mail at shannon.miller@alaska.gov. The comments must be received not later than 11:59pm on February 22, 2022.

We will respond to questions that are relevant to the proposed changes if the questions are received in writing at least ten days before the end of the public comment period. If questions are submitted after that, we may, but we are not required to respond to those questions. The questions and answers will be available on the Department of Environmental Conservation's website at https://dec.alaska.gov/eh/vet/regulations/raw-milk-and-products/. One consolidated answer may be provided for a group of questions that are similar, as appropriate.

We do not respond individually to comments on proposed regulations changes. After we have a chance to review the written comments received and then consider them in deciding what changes (if any) to make in our regulations, we will prepare a summary of the comments and our responses to them, which will be sent to everyone who submits a timely written comment on the proposed changes and provides a return mailing or email address. Individual commenters will not be identified in the summary; however, the comments themselves are public records subject to public inspection.
