5. Wherever cited in this subsection, the Alaska Water Quality Criteria Manual means the Alaska Water Quality Criteria for Toxic and Other Deleterious Organic and Inorganic Substances, dated {adoption date of regulations}[DECEMBER 12, 2008], adopted by reference in this subsection.

18 AAC 70.020(b) NOTES is amended to repeal note 13 in its entirety:
