HOW/WHEN SPILL WAS DISCOVERED AND REPORTED: The spill was discovered at approximately 12:00 a.m. on

March 14, 2018 and reported to ADEC at 11:30 a.m. on March 14, 2018.

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: Diesel fuel / 22,000 gallon

**CAUSE OF SPILL:** Human error during the transfer of fuel from the 26,500 gallon storage tank to the 3000 gallon day tank.

**SOURCE CONTROL:** Fuel transfer was shut down. Tank area is believed to be diked and lined to contain spilled fuel.

**RESPONSE ACTION:** Facility personnel are evaluating recovery options

**RESOURCES AT RISK OR AFFECTED:** No impact to resources outside of the tank farm containment have been reported.

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMENDATIONS: ADEC is sending a responder to Savoonga
