TIME/DATE OF DISTRIBUTION: March 30th, 2018 12:00 PM

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): Alaska Department of Administration

INCIDENT LOCATION: 113 Front Street Nome, Alaska

TIME/DATE OF SPILL: Morning of 3/27/2018

HOW/WHEN SPILL WAS DISCOVERED AND REPORTED: The spill was discovered on the morning of March 27th when office building was found to have no heat. The spill was reported to the DEC office on 3/29/2018

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: Up to 1,400 gallons of diesel fuel from above ground storage tank

CAUSE OF SPILL: Crack was discovered in area of fuel line between the above ground storage tank and the office building.

SOURCE CONTROL: 20 gallons of free product were recovered and fuel line was repaired. Site delineation work is underway

RESPONSE ACTION: Workers from Alaska Dpt. of Transportation have conducted some product recovery and site delineation activities. Two DEC responders are on route to the spill site

RESOURCES AT RISK OR AFFECTED: The state office building in Nome is on Front Street, which is located in close proximity to the Nome Beach and Bering Sea

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: Site delineation activities will be necessary to determine volume of spill and response tactics that will be needed.

WEATHER: Cloudy 25 F with snow likely. Wind 9 mph to East.
