Lead Service Line Grant Application Instructions

- 1. Eligibility: Grant recipients must serve a population less than 3,300 and meet one of the following categories:
 - Municipally owned;
 - Privately owned not-for-profit community water system; or
 - Privately owned not-for-profit non-community, non-transient system.
- 2. **Applicant Information:** Print or type the applicant information. The applicant is the entity that will receive the grant, if awarded. The contact noted on the application should be knowledgeable about the application and able to be contacted during business hours.

Prior to receiving funding assistance, the entity must have a SAM.gov Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) and the UEI must be included on the application. Applicants may obtain a UEI at no cost from the System for Award Management (SAM) website: https://www.sam.gov/SAM/. Should you need assistance with this process, call the toll-free help desk at 1-866-606-8220 or learn more at https://www.fsd.gov/gsafsd_sp. Applicants who have a prior

enrollment with SAM.gov should only have to log into their account to obtain their UEI. Applicants must attach a screenshot/printout of the SAM.gov website showing the applicant's UEI to this Lead Service Line Grant application.

The authorized representative is the person designated by the application to sign official documents and to speak on behalf of the applicant on project related matters.

• PWS with single service connection: November 1, 2023

• Between 2-25 service connections: January 24, 2024

More than 25 service connections: April 24, 2024
