NRC Alaska is pleased to provide the following Project Status update for the Wrangell Junkyard Solid Waste transportation and disposal Project. Our goal is to provide a status update on a weekly basis, with photos and notes as appropriate so that all interested parties may remain apprised on progress in the field on a regular basis. We are currently performing work as detailed in the soil transport and disposal plan and the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) for the project as detailed under Alaska Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (APDES) permit # AKR10FQ51. This Project Status Update covers project activities as performed between June 2, 2018 and June 10, 2018.

Project Activities:

Activities during the 2018 field season will focus on the loading of Flexible Intermediate Bulk Containers (FIBC). Transfer of FIBC's to the Silver Bay Logging Mill Site (SBLMS) barge staging area for loading and transport to a disposal facility in Oregon. Implementation of initial SWPPP measures and road maintenance.

Project activities accomplished:

- NRC Alaska mobilized to Wrangell, AK on June 2, 2018.
- NRC Alaska and BW Enterprises prepared the Byford Junkyard soil stockpile site, including construction of a FIBC loading pad/area and improvements to the access road into this loading area.
- **NRC Alaska** performed weekly SWPPP inspections.
- NRC Alaska and BW Enterprises prepared the barge loading area at the SBLMS and made improvements to the access road located at mile 6.2 of the Zimovia Highway.

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Project Challenges Encountered:

• No specific challenges encountered this week.

Anticipated Project activities:

- **NRC Alaska** will inspect the site monthly per the SWPPP requirements, and also inspect the existing stockpile.
- NRC Alaska and BW Enterprises will begin loading FIBC's and transporting to SBLMS barge loading area for staging and eventual transport to disposal facility.
