Standard Operating Permit Condition VI – Good Air Pollution Control Practices

Emission Unit [SOURCE] Categories This Condition Applies to: All emission units [SOURCES] that are not insignificant or that use a control device, except that standard permit condition VI does not apply

1. to any emission unit [SOURCE] subject to an emission standard in 40 C.F.R. 60, 40 C.F.R. 61, or 40 C.F.R. 63; or
2. if, for each emissions standard that applies, there is continuous emissions monitoring or the permit writer finds that continuous parametric monitoring or frequency of other periodic monitoring is sufficient that equipment performance affecting emissions will not deteriorate between monitoring events.

The department will use standard permit condition VI in any operating permit unless the department determines that emission unit [SOURCE] or stationary source [FACILITY] specific conditions more adequately meet the requirements of 18 AAC 50.

Permit Wording:

1. Good Air Pollution Control Practice.

- 1.1 The permittee shall do the following for emission units [SOURCES] <identify emission units [SOURCES]>:
 - a. perform regular maintenance considering the manufacturer's or the operator's maintenance procedures;
 - b. keep records of any maintenance that would have a significant effect on emissions; the records may be kept in electronic format;
 - c. keep a copy of either the manufacturer's or the operator's maintenance procedures.

The following applies to this standard permit condition:

1. Condition VI.1.1 will
 - list all emission units [SOURCES] with a control device ; and
 - for emission units [SOURCES] without a control device, list only those emission units [SOURCES] that are not insignificant under 18 AAC 50.326(d) - (i).
